Speech and Drama

why Join us

Speech and Drama classes are made up of a range of drama and voice-related activities designed to improve self-confidence, communication skills and presentation skills. My classes incorporate monologues, poetry and prose to engage and inspire students to foster a love of reading and literature as well as mime, public speaking, improvisations and acting / dramatics and much more! Individual lesson students also have the opportunity to take part in an assortment of performance opportunities including a Speech & Drama Showcase, the Sunshine Coast Junior Eisteddfod and undertaking examinations with Trinity College (London).

The 30 minute individual lesson will provide your child with strong foundations for public speaking, building confidence, speech and drama. Students will also learn basic theatre skills such as characterisation, improvisation and voice projection, whilst developing self-confidence and learning about the importance of non-verbal behaviour such as facial expression, movement and gesture. This lesson is usually held during school time and is timetabled on a rotating basis so that students will not miss more than 30 minutes of any class.

The 1 hour acting workshops after school will provide your child with the foundations for the acting craft through role play, character development and improvisation and develop social skills through interaction with peers, role play and group discussion. The 3.15 pm group on Tuesday or Thursday (recommended for our primary schoolers) will focus on theatre skills such as team building, improvisation, basic character building and age appropriate text/ script analysis. The 4.15 pm lesson (recommended for high schoolers) will take the student to the next level of drama discovery with focus on fine-tuning the introductory skills with a greater focus on text, scenes and character development.

Each level is designed to give a skill set that will provide our students, a gift for life.

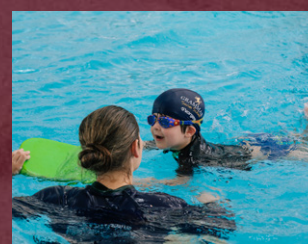

Water Polo

Sunshine Coast Grammar School has had a long involvement with the sport of Water Polo having been involved in the Sunshine Coast School's Water Polo competition since 2004. The Water Polo program offers students of all ability levels the chance to be part of this exciting sport by fielding teams into the Monday Night Sunshine Coast School's Water Polo Competition that runs across Terms 3 and 4. This competition allows both boys and girls the opportunity to participate in the Primary Competition (for Years 5-6), the Junior Competition (Years 7-8), the Intermediate Competition (Years 9-10) and the Open Competition (Years 11-12) in both A and B divisions.

In preparation for this competition, students are offered training on Wednesday mornings from 6.30 – 7.30am at the Grammar Aquatic Centre commencing in Term 2. These training sessions are run by experienced coaches who concentrate on developing the fundamental Water Polo skills of each participant, irrespective of ability level. These coaches in the past have included the ex-Head Coach of the Slovenian Men's team, and ex-National League players. These sessions provide the platform and the pathway for high level Water Polo, as evidenced by two former students – Billy Miller, Sunshine Coast Grammar School's first ever Olympian, being part of the Australian Mens team that contested the London Olympics, and Kasey Dalziel who is currently a member of the QLD Women's Open Water Polo team.

If your child currently likes swimming and is looking for a sport that utilises swimming skills, Water Polo may be the option you are looking for.
