The General Levy includes excursions, camps (Year Level), Secondary book levy, sports and HPE levies, subject levies, etc.

Students who undertake studies in Vocational Education & Training Courses are advised that additional fees apply. Parents will be invoiced directly by the Registered Training Organisation.

Ancillary Fees

Tuition and General Levy fees <u>do not include</u> uniforms and stationery. Extra-curricular camps and activities (including sporting camps), aquatic, rugby and tennis activities, overseas trips, private instrumental tuition, instrument hire and other specialist activities/sports will be costed on an individual basis. Instrumental hire will be charged at the rate of \$80 per term.

Library Late Fees

All overdue Secondary library books not returned by the end of each term will incur a non-refundable fee of \$25 (including GST) per book and \$90 for other subject textbooks. All Primary library books not returned by the end of each term will incur a non-refundable fee of \$20 and magazines \$10. The Library Late Fees will be invoiced separately to Tuition Fees and Levies and will be payable within 14 days.

Due Dates for Payment of Fees

School fees are invoiced twice per year, prior to the commencement of each school semester, and are payable on or before the first day of each semester. Payment can be made by Direct Deposit, Cash (up to \$10,000), B-Pay, Credit Card (Mastercard and Visa), or via *Edstart* (www.edstart.com.au).

In 2023, due dates for fees are as follows: Semester 1 School Fees – full payment is required by 23 January 2023 Semester 2 School Fees – full payment is required by 10 July 2023

New Students

Semester 1, 2023 fees for new commencing students are required to be paid by 9 January 2023.

Sibling Discount

The following Sibling Discounts are applicable when there is more than one sibling attending the Sunshine Coast Grammar School simultaneously - a 5% discount will apply for the second child, 10% for the third child, 15% for the fourth child and subsequent. This concession is only available to parents not in receipt of any greater concession for a student. Please note this discount is applicable to Tuition Fees only and does not apply to Levies or other charges.
